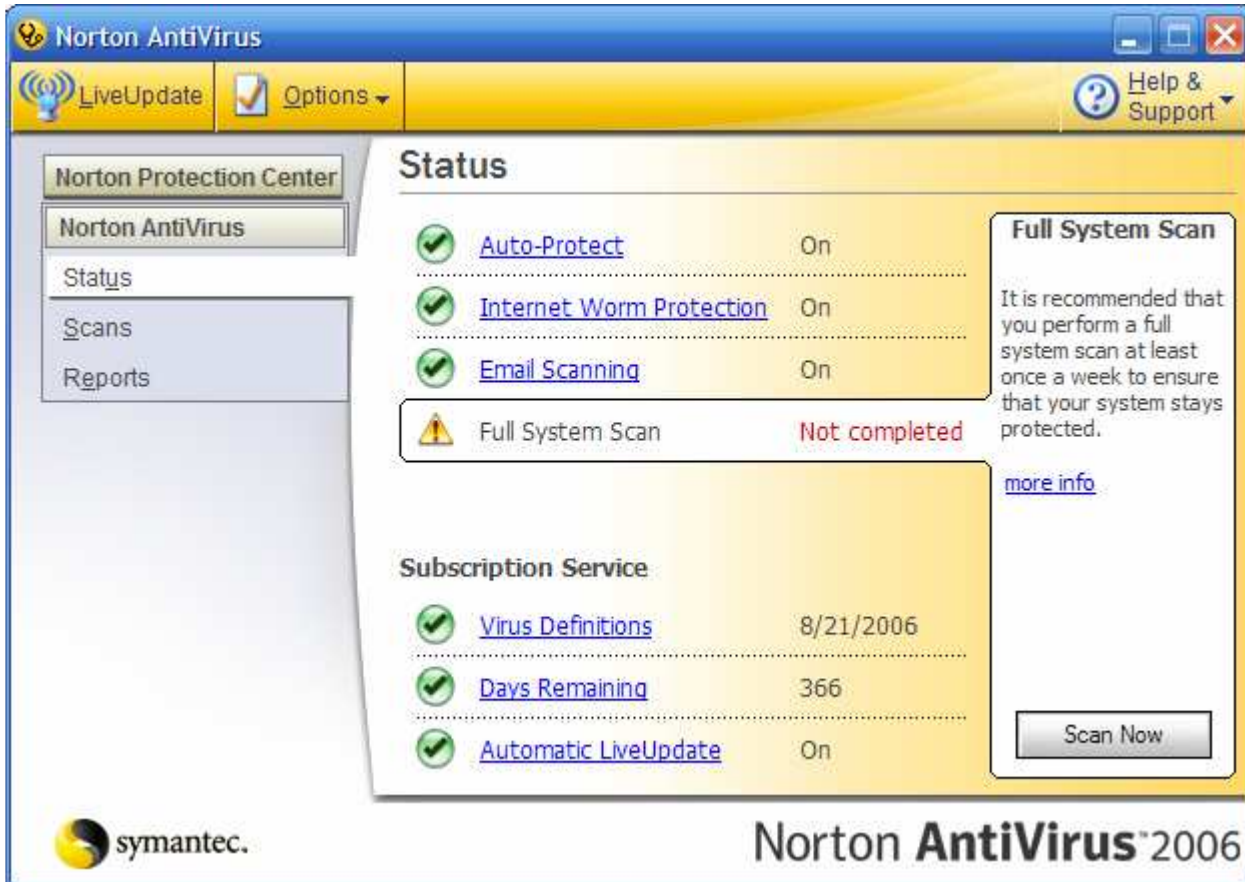


## Norton Antivirus 2006 Walkthrough

### Step 1:

Locate the Norton Antivirus by going to your start button: START > ALL PROGRAMS > NORTON ANTIVIRUS > NORTON ANTIVIRUS. You may also access it by Double-Clicking the Norton Icon in your taskbar tray (by the clock in the lower right-hand corner of your desktop). This will bring you to the Norton Status Screen and the window below should appear.



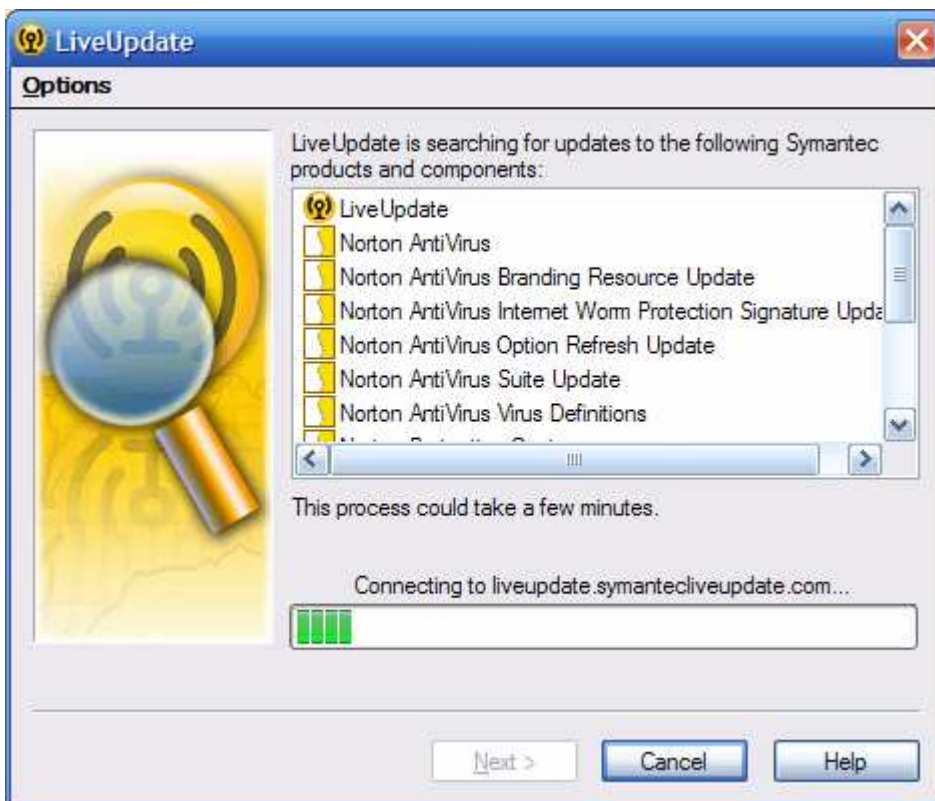
Make sure that each option has a green “√” (check mark) next to it. Any item with a yellow “!” (yield sign) or a red “X” (stop sign) should be addressed by clicking that item and Left-Clicking its appropriate solution option in the lower right-hand corner of the Status Screen.

### Step 2:

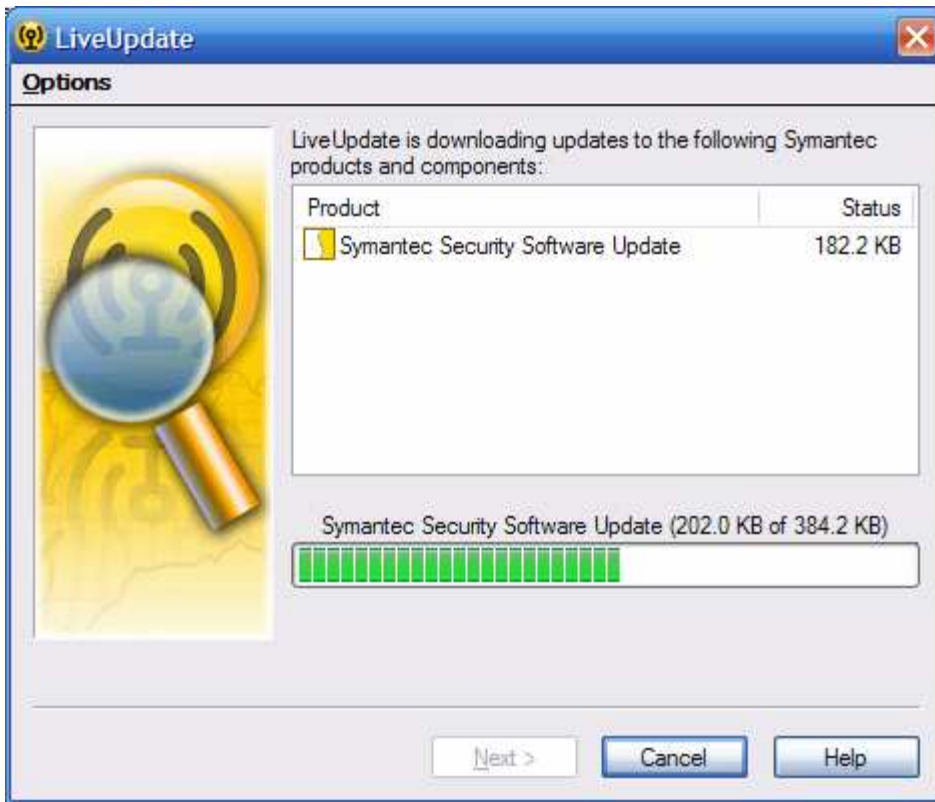
Check to see if there are any updates available from the Symantec server. To do so, Left-Click on the “Live Update” button in the upper left hand corner of the Status Screen. A dialogue box similar to the one below should appear.



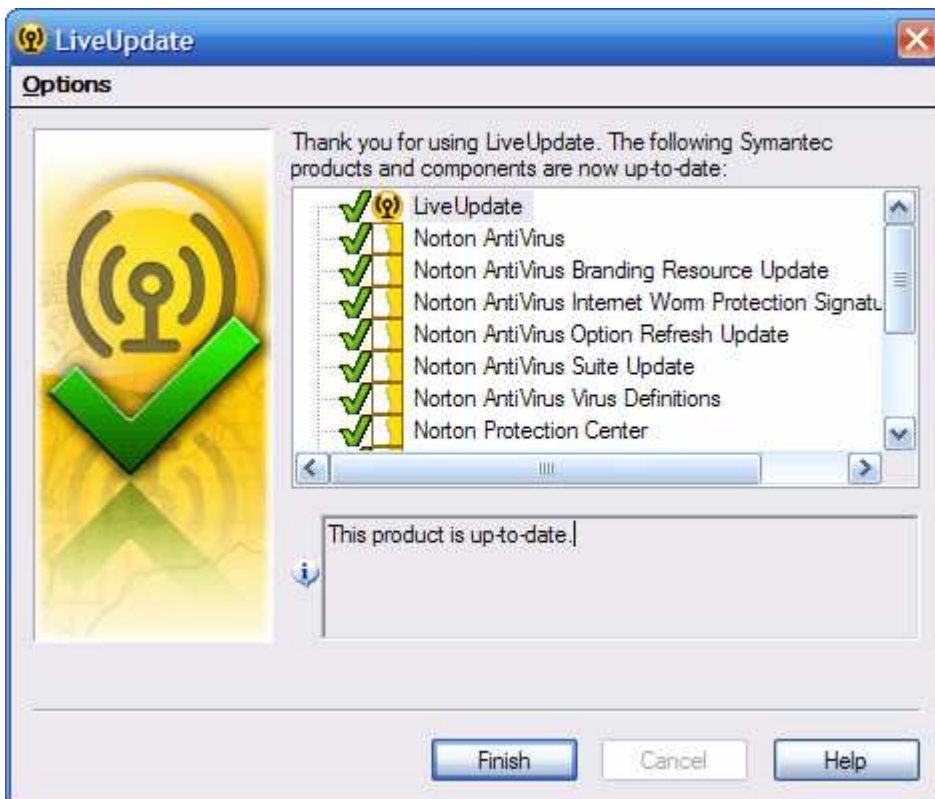
Left-click “Next”; this process will take a few seconds to determine the updates necessary for your PC. After the system scan is complete the following dialogue box should appear.



Install any updates that are itemized in this list. Each item in the list should be check marked for download by default. Left-click on “Next” to begin the download process. The following dialogue box should appear.



This process is two-fold. First, your PC will download all of the necessary updates from the Symantec server. Second, the updates will install one by one automatically. The dialogue box will then change to look as follows.

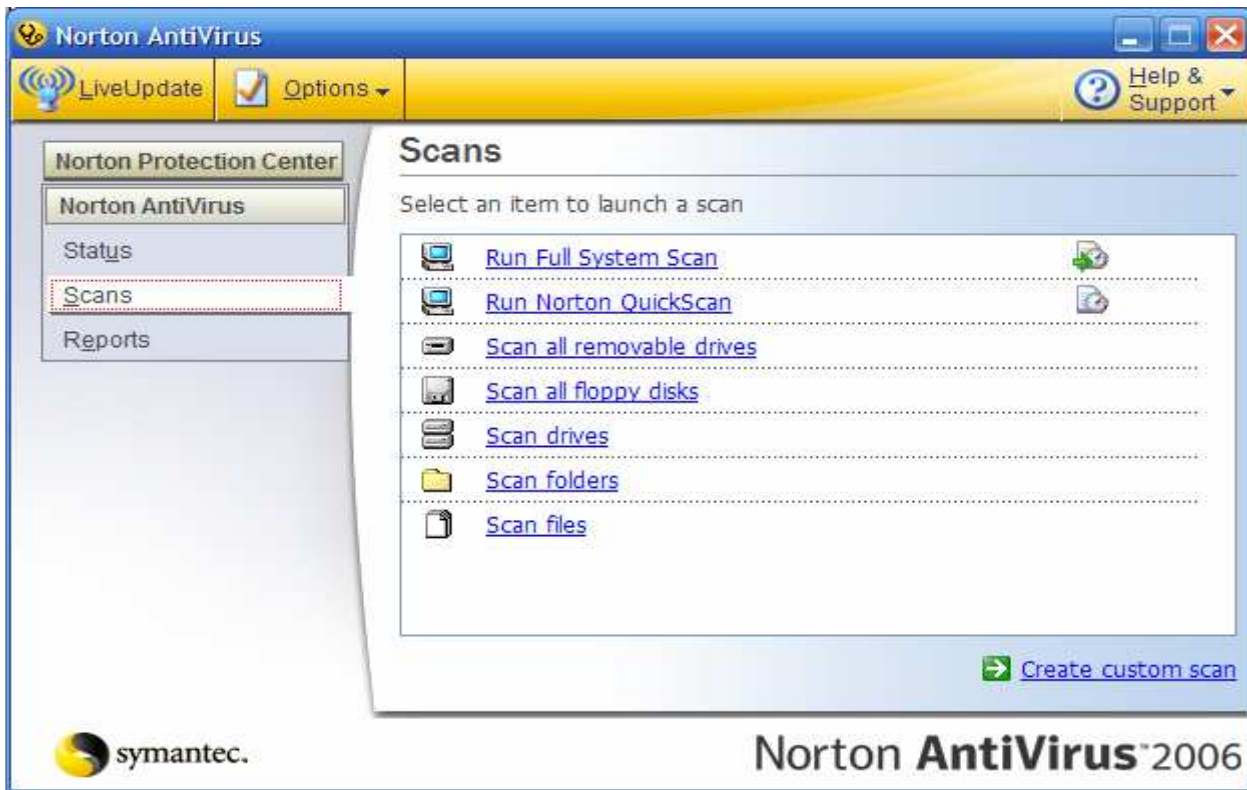


Left-click “finish” to get back to the Norton Status screen to commence scanning your PC.

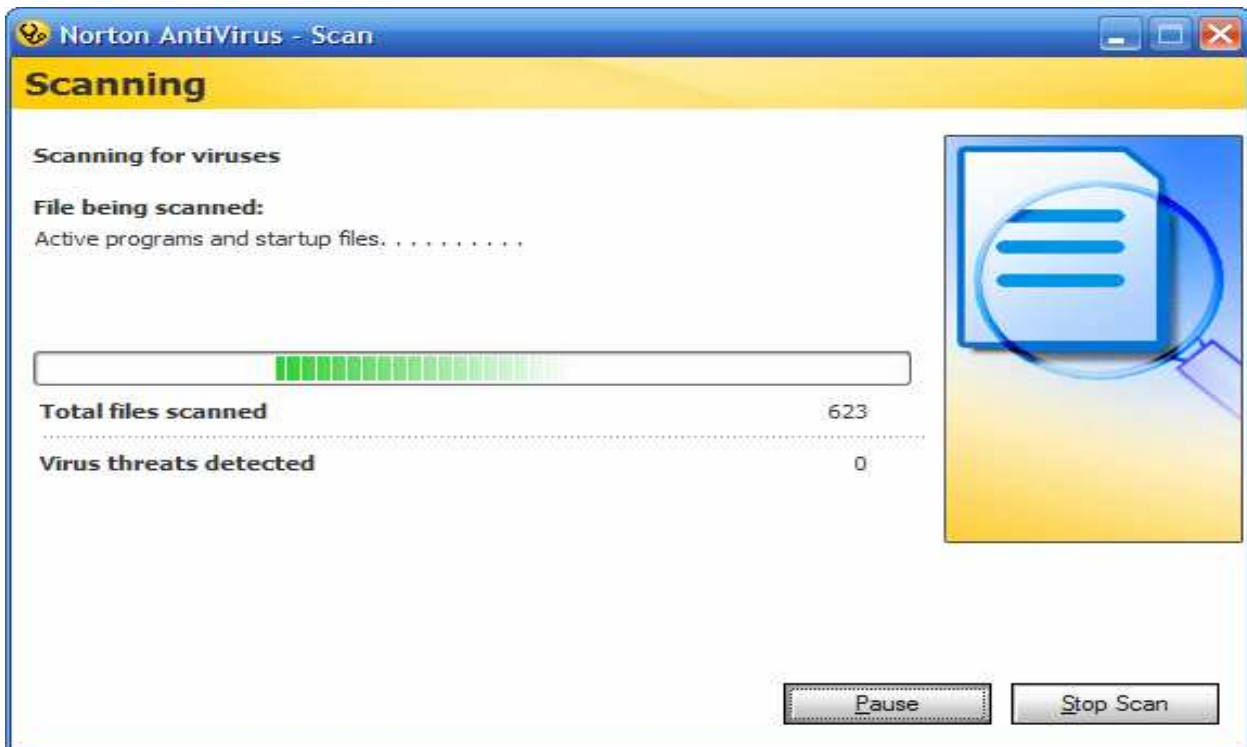
*\*Note: If the updates prompt you to restart your PC, do so immediately and resume scanning after the system has restarted and by repeating from step 1.*

**Step 3:**

Scan your PC by Left-clicking on the “scans” option in the middle left-hand side of the status window. The following dialogue box should appear.



Left-click on “Run Full System Scan” to initiate the scan. The following dialogue box should appear.  
*\*Note: You can choose other methods of scan from the list, Full is recommended.*



This is the scanning process that can take up to or even longer than 1 hour. The program will continue scanning your PC until all files have been scanned and any threats have been detected. After the scan is complete (and assuming you do not have viruses) the following dialogue box should appear.



Left-click "Finish" and the scanning process is complete and you should then be returned to the Status Screen to see green "√" (check marks) for each item in the list. You may now close the Status Screen window and return to your desktop.
